## Speed reduced at David Low Way, Diddillibah

The speed limit on David Low Way, between approximately the Fishermans Road and Petrie Creek Road intersections, will change next week (w/c 14 September).

Transport and Main Roads Deputy Regional Director for North Coast Leah McKenzie said a speed limit review had been completed.

“TMR has undertaken a speed limit review of David Low Way, Diddillibah,” Ms McKenzie said.

Ms McKenzie said the review process considered a range of factors such as road function, roadside environment, road construction standards, prevailing traffic speeds and crash history.

“In consideration of these factors, its recommended to permanently reduce the speed limit from 70km/h to 60km/h,” she said.

“This has been endorsed by the Sunshine Coast Speed Management Committee which includes representatives from the Queensland Police Service, Sunshine Coast Council and Transport and Main Roads.

“I urge all motorists to observe the new speed limit signs and to always drive to the conditions.”
