Seeking feedback on the bridge over the Balonne River, Surat

- The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) is looking at options to upgrade the approaches and bridge over the Balonne River, Surat.
- The bridge over the Balonne River is on the Carnarvon Highway (Surat Roma) just north of the township of Surat.
- TMR will be seeking feedback from residents, businesses and industries on how previous flooding events have affected them.

TMR is planning to enhance the infrastructure around the Balonne River Bridge. The primary goal is to develop options to upgrade both the bridge and its approaches.

To ensure that the upgrade plans align with the needs and experiences of the community, TMR is organising a community information session in Surat, at the Hub on 18 January 2024 from 9am to 4pm. This session will provide a platform for community members and businesses to share their insights, experiences, and suggestions related to the impact of flooding events.
