Start of Works: Tamborine–Oxenford Road and Michigan Drive intersection upgrade

- Works will soon start on Tamborine–Oxenford Road and Michigan Drive intersection upgrade
- Signalisation of the intersection will improve safety for all road users
- Project is expected to be completed in late 2024

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) will commence work on the Tamborine–Oxenford Road and Michigan Drive intersection upgrade this month, which will improve safety for all road users.

Key project works include the installation of intersection traffic signals and pedestrian crossing signals, pavement surfacing over 600 metres, relocation of street lighting and dedicated turn lanes into Georgina Street from Tamborine–Oxenford Road.

Work will primarily be undertaken during weekdays with some night and weekend work as required.

The project is expected to be completed in late 2024 (weather and site conditions permitting).
