

Traffic changes: Mt Gravatt-Capalaba Road westbound changes

November 2014

Project Update

Mt Gravatt Capalaba Road is being widened to allow for additional traffic lanes, with a new bridge being constructed over Bulimba Creek for westbound traffic.

Following asphaltting and linemarking activities during October and November, westbound traffic on Mt Gravatt-Capalaba Road will be redirected onto the new bridge.

The changes to westbound traffic will take place during nightworks on **Friday 28 November, 2014**.

From **5am Saturday 29 November, 2014**, all westbound traffic will be realigned onto the new bridge.

Eastbound traffic will continue on the existing road. Following the traffic changes, works will focus on rehabilitating the existing bridge to allow for additional lane capacity. Further traffic changes will be required in early 2015.

Every effort will be made to reduce potential construction impacts and nearby residents and motorists may experience some noise and traffic delays. We will keep the community updated regarding further works.

What to expect during these works:

- Changed traffic conditions will be in place. Motorists are requested to drive carefully, follow the direction of roadside signs and traffic controllers, and allow for additional travel time through worksites.
- Traffic control and signage will be in place to guide motorists.
- In order to minimise disruption to traffic and ensure the safety of motorists and road workers, these works will take place during night works between 8pm and 5am.
- Following this temporary traffic switch there will be two lanes operational in each direction.
- The traffic switch date is subject to weather and construction conditions. If conditions restrict activities, works will be postponed to the next available date.
