

### Air Quality Management Report – Form 1

This document is to be filled out by the developer of land that adjoins a state-controlled road on which air quality sensitive activities may take place. It is to be submitted to the Regional Director of the Department of Transport and Main Roads in support of a development application. The information provided will be used to assess whether the presence of air quality sensitive activities on the land will restrict the use of the state-controlled road.

Definitions of technical terms are provided in the Road Traffic Air Quality Management Manual glossary, for users who may be unfamiliar with technical terminology.

13. If the answer to (11) or (12) is Y (Yes), then a Road Traffic Air Quality Management Report will generally be required. The contents of the report should be as described in relevant sections of chapters 3-5 of the Road Traffic Air Quality Management Manual. Report attached (Y/N) .....
