







PLANTING BROADACRE AREAS <25L CONTAINER SLOPE ≤ 1 ON 4









Staking Schedule

600 x 10 diameter bamboo	Tube — 200mm stock (Marker for supplementary planting in seeded areas only)	-	1
1500 x 25 x 25 hardwood	25 - 40L (Tree species only)	Yes	2
1800 X 50 X 50 hardwood	100L stock (Tree species only)	Yes	2
Guys	≥ 200L and ex-ground	-	-

NOTES:

- 1. AMELIORATION: Where subsoil amelioration is required, ameliorants shall be applied to the surface prior to ground preparation operations (ripping, cultivation or roughening).
- 2. GROUND PREPARATION: shall be carried out parallel to the contours.
- 3. GROUND PREPARATION adjacent to hardstand areas shall be in accordance with Standard Drawing 1644.
- 4. GROUND PREPARATION in kerbed medians and separators, shall be in accordance with Standard Drawing 1643.
- 5. GROUND PREPARATION: Non-conforming stone, rubble and other deleterious material brought to the surface during ground preparation operations, shall be removed.
- 6. ROUGHENING shall roughen and form keys in the subsoil to prevent subsequent material slipping down the face.
- 7. RIPPING is required only where ground has been:
 - previously compacted; or
 - used by vehicular traffic.
 - ie. decommissioned site compounds, building pads, parking areas, stock pile areas, roads and haul routes
- 8. RIPPING shall shatter compacted subsoil sufficiently to allow the subsequent cultivation
- 9. CULTIVATION shall break up the surface of the subsoil sufficiently to produce a finely tilled material.
- 10. GROUND PREPARATION: Non-conforming stone, rubble and other deleterious material that is brought to the surface during ground preparation operations, shall be removed. 11. FERTILISER shall be placed at approximately half the hole depth. Fertiliser shall not be
- placed at the base of the plant or in contact with the plant's root system. 12. TOPSOIL: Depths are after settlement has occurred. Allowance shall be made for
- settlement during installation.
- 13. TOPSOIL: After installation no compaction is to occur apart from compaction resulting from mulching or other planting operations.
- 14. MULCH shall not contaminate planting hole material.
- 15.MULCH shall be evenly spread smooth. Depths are minimum depths after settlement has occurred. Allowance shall be made for settlement during installation.
- 16.PLANTS must be installed in accordance with design constraints (clearzone, sight visibility, and other vegetation setbacks and clearances);
 - as shown on the Drawings; or
 - in the Road Landscape Manual Appendix 4, where not shown on the Drawings
- 17.PLANT: Sufficient plant tags shall be left on plants to allow identification of each plant species in any given area.
- 18. STAKING: Where staking within 5m of hardstand areas, stakes are to be installed parallel to the hardstand area.
- 19. BROADACRE: The areas beyond the toe of a fill embankment or top of a cut batter that have been disturbed.
- 20.CONTAINED AREAS: Medians, separators and planting beds bordered by garden edging. 21.DIMENSIONS are in millimetres unless shown otherwise.
