Caloundra South - Infrastructure Agreement (State Transport Infrastructure) Bells Creek Arterial Road Phase 3 and Phase 4 Certificate of Completion and Acceptance of Works "On-Maintenance"

I refer to the *Works Approval Notice – with conditions* issued by the Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) on 4th December 2020, as amended 17 December 2020 (Works Approval Notice).

Notification has been received by TMR that works have been completed. TMR has taken steps to satisfy itself that the works have been undertaken in accordance with the approved plans and the conditions of approval and accepts the completion of the road, subject to the outstanding defects being addressed (as detailed in the email from ^{P/I} WSP, dated 14 December 2023, with further clarifications provided on 15th December 2023).

In addition, it is noted that Stockland are still to install cover plates to the four guide signs at CH49.09 and CH50.05 northbound and CH51.59 and CH52.58 southbound on the Bruce Highway.

Please note, that while TMR has accepted that the works have been completed, the works will remain on maintenance for the following periods from 19th September 2023, during which time Stockland remain responsible for rectifying any defects associated with the works:

- **Pavement** 12 months
- Landscape (grass) 12 months from the point of re-turfing/seeding and root growth.
 (Note: landscape planting/embellishments remains the responsibility of Stockland, as set out in the Land and Asset Maintenance Plans.)
- Structures 6 months
- Civils (excl pavement) 6 months
- *Electrical/ITS* 6 months

At the end of the maintenance periods, Stockland may notify TMR requesting that TMR provide a Final Works Certificate confirming the works contribution is no longer on maintenance. TMR will assess this request in accordance with clause 47.15 of the Infrastructure Agreement.

There is also a requirement for Stockland to implement monitoring of frog presence/absence surveys once per year to determine the effectiveness of the existing infrastructure as a frog movement barrier onto Bells Creek Arterial Road. This is required to be undertaken for a period of 3 years, and yearly reports are to be submitted to TMR (at Stockland's cost). If the risk is shown to be such that the existing infrastructure is not sufficient, the developer must rectify the situation. The cost of the subsequent design and construction of frog fencing shall be borne by the developer.

'As constructed' plans of the Works Contribution (both hard and electronic copies) are required to be submitted to TMR by Stockland, and 'as constructed' specifications containing such details as may be required by TMR.
