


Delineators omitted for clarity



NOTES:

- Delineator brackets shall be moulded from high impact non metallic ultra violet stable material. The style and shape of the brackets may vary with manufacturer's specifications and have mounting options to meet specific locations and requirements. All corners shall be rounded.
- 2. Delineators to comply with the requirements specified in MRTS14. Delineators may be circular or rectangular as specified.
- 3. Fastener not to unduly pressure Delineator. Fastener to be unaffected by corrosion in normal road environment.
- 4. Delineators used on median concrete barriers that are centrally located to have Yellow Delineators on both faces. In other cases, the colour of the Delineators shall be determined with regard to the situation of the barrier(s). Refer to examples.
- 5. Siting, Alignment and spacing to be as detailed in the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (Part 2 Section 4.2.4) unless specified otherwise in the Contract.
- 6. Dimensions are in millimetres unless shown otherwise.
