I have just been advised that Jarrod Bleijie, Member for Kawana has written to the Minister (MC135921 attached) seeking the Minister to facilitate a meeting between him, Scott and the Kawana Island Residents Association as he hasn't had a response from us

The team have been requested to provide a response from Min to MP but aren't sure how to prepare this and are seeking some direction^{NR} [REDACTED]

I did mention that we should include information regarding our meeting with a KIRA representative on the 7 August 2023 and potentially utilising some of the dotters below that were progressed up the line following the meeting

- Mr Chris Bourke, KIRA Chairperson, attended and the meeting was largely positive
- Mr Bourke was supportive of the MRI Upgrade project and recognised its need
- Mr Bourke shared resident concerns about the timing of letters to directly impacted property owners and release of preliminary design showing impacts
- TMR advised every effort was made to contact all property owners prior to release and unfortunately availability of owners meant some individual meetings were held following release of the design – however, correspondence to owners was sent prior to release
- TMR outlined the reasons for the newly identified property impacts and reiterated there is no immediate impact to the properties, as future stages of the project are currently unfunded and timeframes unknown
- TMR explained owners are eligible to apply for early acquisition of their property – however, this is not compulsory and is simply an option available to them
- Mr Bourke asked about provision for e-scooters/mobility scooters and TMR explained the active transport provisions included in MRI Upgrade project design
- Mr Bourke shared concerns from The Groves residents about noise from the new overpass connecting Nicklin Way and Brisbane Road. TMR explained noise mitigation measures being considered as part of the project design and advised the project team had reached out to The Groves to discuss the matter in detail.

I am writing with reference to emails sent from my electorate office, dated 20 July 2023 and 27 July 2023 respectively, to the Department of Transport and Main Roads requesting an urgent meeting with Mr Scott Whitaker, Regional Director of the North Coast Region with regards to the Mooloolah River Interchange.

A number of local residents, as well as members of the Kawana Island Residents Association ("the KIRA") have contacted me to raise concerns about the possible resumption of their homes in Fitzroy Court, Parrearra.

As a result, I sought a meeting with Mr Whitaker, departmental representatives, and a representative from the KIRA to discuss the concerns of these residents.

Unfortunately, as of yet, I have not received a response despite repeated requests.

I have met with many of the residents who will potentially be impacted by the amended alignment of the Mooloolah River Interchange and who would like straight answers from the Department of Transport and Main Roads about the future of their homes.

The apparent reluctance of TMR officials to meet with me about the concerns of my constituents raises significant questions about the Queensland Government's commitment to appropriate transparency and accountability mechanisms with respect to the administration of this project.

I am particularly troubled by the possibility that Mr Whitaker has been specifically directed against proceeding with a meeting with me so that the Government is able to avoid scrutiny on this issue.

Again, I urgently request that you take action to facilitate a meeting between myself and the aforementioned parties so that I can assist my constituents.

I look forward to your prompt response.

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) has released a design layout for the Sunshine Motorway, Mooloolah River Interchange (MRI) Upgrade. The MRI is the key to unlocking several significant road and rail projects, and will deliver a safe, efficient and effective network to meet the current and future transport needs of the Sunshine Coast.

A design layout has been developed for the entire MRI Upgrade project. It considers community feedback received during project planning, as well as a range of technical, design and on-site investigations undertaken over the last 18 months. TMR thanks the community and key stakeholders for feedback and helping shape this significant infrastructure upgrade.

The MRI Upgrade project will provide new north-south connectivity between Maroochydore, Birtinya, Caloundra and southern growth areas.

It is the first step towards several significant road and rail projects in the region and is the trigger for major infrastructure transformation on the Sunshine Coast.

The Australian and Queensland governments have jointly committed \$320 million in funding, on a 50:50 (federal:state) basis, for design and construction of the first stage of the MRI Upgrade project.

Stage 1

Stage 1 will deliver:

- a new road overpass to provide a more direct and efficient connection from Nicklin Way to Brisbane Road at Mooloolaba
- a new local road connection between Karawatha Drive at Mountain Creek and Brisbane Road at Mooloolaba.

These new connections will significantly improve safety by separating local traffic from high-speed motorway traffic and reducing traffic weaving.

The Stage 1 works need to be delivered first to enable construction of the project's future stages.

Funding is required to progress future stages to construction. Please refer to the design layout overleaf for further details.

Project background

Between 2007 and 2010, extensive planning and community consultation for an upgrade of the Sunshine Motorway at the Mooloolah River was undertaken as part of the Multi-Modal Transport Corridor (MMTC) study.

Significant community feedback was received and considered by TMR, with design variations explored and further consultation taking place. This focused on the new connection over the Mooloolah River.

In 2014, the MRI Upgrade project was established, which focused on refining the design. The updated design included a new, largely land-based alignment for the Mooloolah River crossing with a series of bridge structures over the waterway. This solution significantly reduced the environmental impacts to the Mooloolah River and was more cost effective.

Detailed planning was then undertaken for the MRI Upgrade, with a planning layout released for community feedback in July and August 2021. Community feedback was invited again in March and April 2022.

Community feedback prompted the redesign of proposed access changes to the Brisbane Road service road at Mooloolaba. The refined design for this section of the project was announced in April 2023 and removed any impact to Neerim Park.



Road traffic noise

TMR understands road traffic noise is of interest to many people who live near the project and recognises the need to consider noise reduction measures. The provision of noise reduction measures is determined in accordance with TMR's Transport Noise Management Code of Practice.

In order to effectively predict noise levels, TMR uses a noise model which has been calibrated for Queensland conditions to predict likely noise levels in an area. The model assumes moderately adverse wind velocities and takes into account current and projected traffic volumes, topography, road surfacing type and other contributing factors.

Noise modelling has been carried out as part of the design process to predict future road traffic noise impacts. This modelling has identified a number of potential sites requiring new or upgraded noise barriers (as shown in the design layout). One of the quietest road surfaces available, open-graded asphalt, will also be used on the Sunshine Motorway, Brisbane Road and the new connection with Karawatha Drive to ensure noise levels are reduced to the greatest extent possible.



Community feedback

More than 250 items of feedback were received via the online engagement platform, email, post and phone during the consultation periods for the planning layout.

Key feedback themes related to design suggestions, road traffic noise impacts, active transport provisions, property impacts, traffic congestion, timing of the upgrade, environmental impacts, visual amenity changes and road user safety.

This valuable feedback has been reviewed and considered during the development of the design layout.



Environmental management

Environmental management and conservation is a high priority for TMR. TMR has been liaising with key stakeholders and the Australian and Queensland governments to discuss environmental issues, share information and ensure legislative requirements are met and, where possible, exceeded.

Through this consultation, many aspects of environmental management have been considered in the design layout and will be included in construction methods for the project. TMR will continue to listen to and work with local environmental stakeholders to ensure best practice is achieved.

TMR will also continue to work closely with the traditional owners of the land, Kabi Kabi First Nation People.



Early works

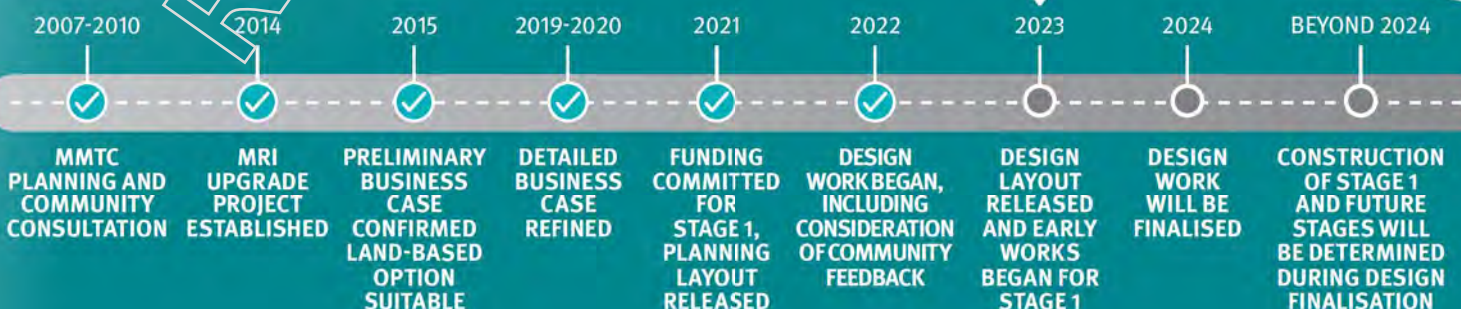
Early works for the MRI Upgrade project started in May 2023. These works will make the site construction-ready and involve:

- settlement of soft soils.

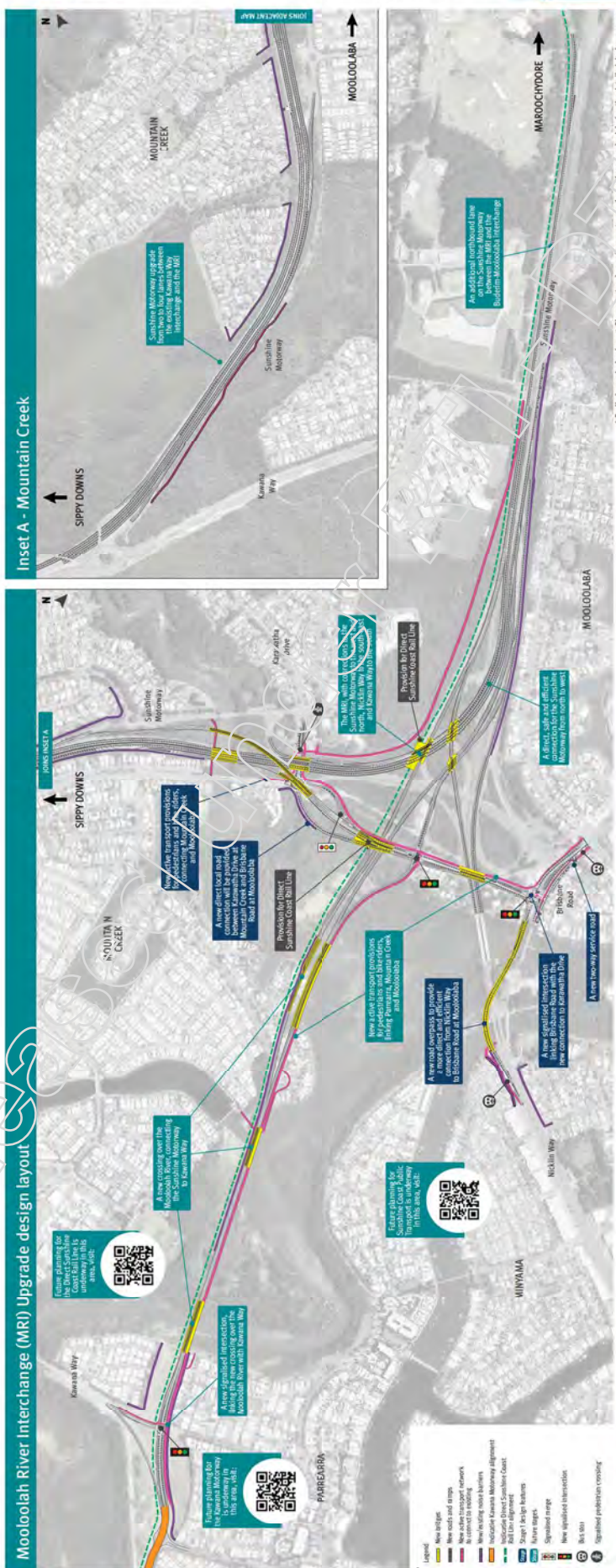

Design work

- THE started design work for the MRI Upgrade project in January 2022 and has developed the design layout during the preliminary design phase. Activities involved a wide range of technical activities, including:
- road and bridge engineering
 - drainage investigation
 - environmental impact and heritage studies
 - utility and water services
 - Transport System design
 - service infrastructure
 - sustainability and innovation considerations
 - active transport and community infrastructure project considerations.

Key benefits

- Increased average peak period travel speeds on the Sunshine Coast resulting in faster and more efficient travel throughout the region.
- Better opportunities to improve north-south travel and access to key economic, employment, and community destinations.
- A new direct connection between the Sunshine Coast and Kawatha Way.
- A new direct connection road link between Kawatha Drive in Mountain Creek and Brisbane Road in Mooloolah.
- An additional northbound parking facility, including a new parking facility, walking lanes, and a new direct connection between the MRI and the Buderim-Mooloolah Interchange.
- Increased active transport opportunities, through the inclusion of new shared pedestrian and bicycle paths, and a barrier profile for the direct connection.

The project design will be finalised to be finished in early 2024. The detailed design phase involves construction of the interchange and specification of road works for construction. The reconstruction program will also be determined during this phase.

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) has released a design layout for the Sunshine Motorway, Mooloolah River Interchange (MRI) Upgrade. The MRI is the key to unlocking several significant road and rail projects, and will deliver a safe, efficient and effective network to meet the current and future transport needs of the Sunshine Coast.

A design layout has been developed for the entire MRI Upgrade project. It considers community feedback received during project planning, as well as a range of technical, design and on-site investigations undertaken over the last 18 months. TMR thanks the community and key stakeholders for feedback and helping shape this significant infrastructure upgrade.

The MRI Upgrade project will provide new north-south connectivity between Maroochydore, Birtinya, Caloundra and southern growth areas.

It is the first step towards several significant road and rail projects in the region and is the trigger for major infrastructure transformation on the Sunshine Coast.

The Australian and Queensland governments have jointly committed \$320 million in funding, on a 50:50 (federal:state) basis, for design and construction of the first stage of the MRI Upgrade project.

Stage 1

Stage 1 will deliver:

- a new road overpass to provide a more direct and efficient connection from Nicklin Way to Brisbane Road at Mooloolaba
- a new local road connection between Karawatha Drive at Mountain Creek and Brisbane Road at Mooloolaba.

These new connections will significantly improve safety by separating local traffic from high-speed motorway traffic and reducing traffic weaving.

The Stage 1 works need to be delivered first to enable construction of the project's future stages.

Funding is required to progress future stages to construction. Please refer to the design layout overleaf for further details.

Project background

Between 2007 and 2010, extensive planning and community consultation for an upgrade of the Sunshine Motorway at the Mooloolah River was undertaken as part of the Multi-Modal Transport Corridor (MMTC) study.

Significant community feedback was received and considered by TMR, with design variations explored and further consultation taking place. This focused on the new connection over the Mooloolah River.

In 2014, the MRI Upgrade project was established, which focused on refining the design. The updated design included a new, largely land-based alignment for the Mooloolah River crossing with a series of bridge structures over the waterway. This solution significantly reduced the environmental impacts to the Mooloolah River and was more cost effective.

Detailed planning was then undertaken for the MRI Upgrade, with a planning layout released for community feedback in July and August 2021. Community feedback was invited again in March and April 2022.

Community feedback prompted the redesign of proposed access changes to the Brisbane Road service road at Mooloolaba. The refined design for this section of the project was announced in April 2023 and removed any impact to Neerim Park.



Road traffic noise

TMR understands road traffic noise is of interest to many people who live near the project and recognises the need to consider noise reduction measures. The provision of noise reduction measures is determined in accordance with TMR's Transport Noise Management Code of Practice.

In order to effectively predict noise levels, TMR uses a noise model which has been calibrated for Queensland conditions to predict likely noise levels in an area. The model assumes moderately adverse wind velocities and takes into account current and projected traffic volumes, topography, road surfacing type and other contributing factors.

Noise modelling has been carried out as part of the design process to predict future road traffic noise impacts. This modelling has identified a number of potential sites requiring new or upgraded noise barriers (as shown in the design layout). One of the quietest road surfaces available, open-graded asphalt, will also be used on the Sunshine Motorway, Brisbane Road and the new connection with Karawatha Drive to ensure noise levels are reduced to the greatest extent possible.



Community feedback

More than 250 items of feedback were received via the online engagement platform, email, post and phone during the consultation periods for the planning layout.

Key feedback themes related to design suggestions, road traffic noise impacts, active transport provisions, property impacts, traffic congestion, timing of the upgrade, environmental impacts, visual amenity changes and road user safety.

This valuable feedback has been reviewed and considered during the development of the design layout.



Environmental management

Environmental management and conservation is a high priority for TMR. TMR has been liaising with key stakeholders and the Australian and Queensland governments to discuss environmental issues, share information and ensure legislative requirements are met and, where possible, exceeded.

Through this consultation, many aspects of environmental management have been considered in the design layout and will be included in construction methods for the project. TMR will continue to listen to and work with local environmental stakeholders to ensure best practice is achieved.

TMR will also continue to work closely with the traditional owners of the land, Kabi Kabi First Nation People.



Early works

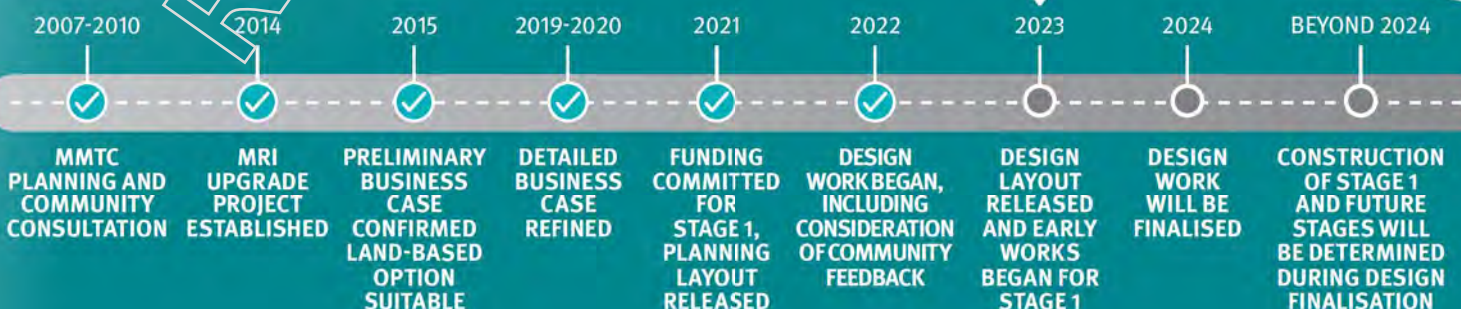

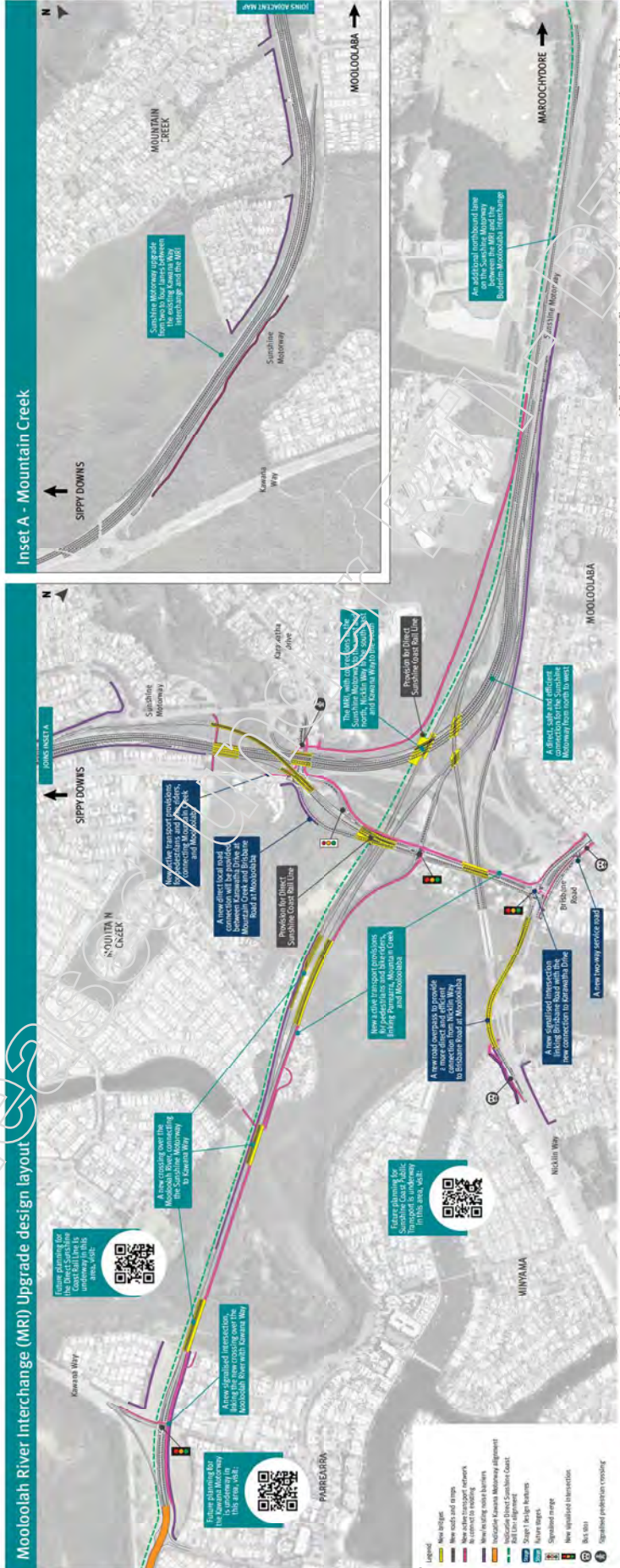


